FROM RECOVERY TO RESILIENCY

The Resiliency Forum Asia 2013 came to a successful close on 30 August 2013. In its inaugural year, the event was attended by 150 experienced practitioners and industry experts, spanning from diverse organizations within the Philippines and across the region.



This Post Event Report is produced with the intention of highlighting the general feedback on the conference this year and to help all prospective participants prepare for the event next year.







Breakdown of Delegates by Industry




Breakdown of Delegates by Jobs Classifications




Overall Venue Assessment
